### **Important**

Foreign nationals interning in the US must participate in the US Dept of State's Exchange Visitor Program and be sponsored by one of the 96 visa sponsors. This program has operated since 2008 and is run directly by a designated visa sponsor. The **program fee of USD 2745 covers designated visa sponsorship and host placement.** The **housing fee is about USD 30 to 120 per day** depending on the room type and occupancy.

### **Subsidy/Funding/Scholarship**

Students are strongly encouraged to apply for the internship as soon as possible in order to start the visa application as early as possible. Students can find out more scholarship opportunities provided by HKU and external organisations at <http://www.scholarships.hku.hk>.

### **Attention**

There is no sponsorship or allowance from CEDARS. Interns are responsible for their own arrangement, including but not limited to air tickets, transportation, insurance, daily expenses etc.

Students are reminded to consider carefully your study plan, the job nature, the organization culture, availability for the whole internship and financial situation etc. before making the application.

It is a compulsory requirement that students are appropriately / sufficiently insured for the whole internship period by themselves. Proof of medical coverage must be provided before the internship commences. Students have to consider the living environment and safety issues in the placement location.

Participants are required to attend the US Consulate Visa interview IN PERSON in HONG KONG. Students who may be engaged in any overseas exchange during Q1 and Q2 2017 may not be considered by the programme.

Serious applicants are strongly suggested to start completing the online forms and document uploads early. The program uses the application process to assess applicants' attitude and competency; thus, pay attention to details.
