Dear Students,

You are a “first-generation” university student if both your grandparents and parents did not receive university education.

**if you have siblings who are also the first-generation in the family to enter university, you’ll BOTH be counted as “first-generation university students”*

You’re invited to apply for the "First-in-the-Family Education Fund" (FIFE Fund). The fund provides support to first-generation university students to engage in outside-classroom learning activities, such as:

- exchange studies
- overseas cultural/study tours/field trips
- service trips/non-local internships
- living in residential halls (subsidy at a maximum of HK\$2,000)
- recreational and interest courses, such as sports, music, arts, language classes

Awards

Each successful applicant will receive HK\$15,000 for participating in different university-administered/supported learning activities.

Eligibility

Current local full-time students, who are:

1. Admitted to full-degree undergraduate programmes of the University in or after September 2008;
2. Being the first-generation university students in their families (i.e., their parents and grandparents do not have any university education);
3. Having a monthly household income of HK\$16,756 or less (for a 4-member family); and
4. Having a total value of savings and assets of HK\$242,000 or less per family member.
