

**Call for Volunteers (7 - 13 June 2019):
Global Health Forum of Boao Forum for Asia, Qingdao, China**

Dear Students,

The Boao Forum for Asia (BFA) will organise a new event, namely "**Global Health Forum of Boao Forum for Asia**" (**the GHF Conference**) in Qingdao from 10 to 12 June 2019. Supported by the World Health Organization, the National Health Commission of the People's Republic of China, and other relevant Chinese ministries and commissions, the GHF Conference is an open platform for the exchange of ideas across the world aiming to find solutions at the public policy and industry levels to many health challenges facing humanity. While providing multi-level thought leadership sharing and exchanges, it also offers a project exchange meeting on more than 100 innovation projects in the field of medical health and population health industry, as well as a Global Health Expo that covers 40,000 square meters. The Education Bureau will coordinate the nomination of volunteers from universities to the Conference. Selection and participation logistics of volunteers will be managed by The Y.Elites Association (Y.Elites), a partner of BFA. HKU will nominate up to 5 students to the Education Bureau.

Details of the arrangement are set out as follows:

Period of Commitment

7 to 13 June 2019 (both dates inclusive)

Eligibility and Requirements

1. **Full-time undergraduate students** of all fields of studies with valid travel documents to enter the Mainland, with priority to be given to students studying in **public health or medical and allied health disciplines**, as this exercise targets to broaden exposure of Hong Kong youths who wish to pursue public health or medical and allied health careers. Social sciences students may also be considered.
2. Fluency in English and Putonghua; being proactive and having an interest in global health affairs and appreciation of the importance of worldview.
3. Being available throughout the whole period of commitment, i.e. from 7 to 13 June 2019.

Participation

The volunteers will be deployed to various working teams, including but not limited to event management, enquiries and logistics support.

Cost

Travel and accommodation expenses will be covered by BFA and Y.Elites respectively. According to Y.Elites, insurance and living expenses during the whole commitment period will also be included for all participating students, except the incidentals.
