- All full-time first year to third year undergraduate students are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be Hong Kong permanent residents with a CGPA of 3.3 or above, and are committed to giving back to the society.

* Admitted students have to fully commit themselves to the programme during the summer vacation of 2016. Only those who show their full commitment are invited to join the overseas service tour to be held in August 2016.

Application:

Only two places are given to each tertiary institution.
