Post A – Event Assistant

- (i) **Responsibilities:**
To assist in preparation of materials, venue set-up, crowd control, usher, registration desk, provide support to on-site logistics.
- (ii) **Requirements:**
HKU current students; responsible and proactive in helping others; friendly and cheerful; good team players with commendable communication and interpersonal skills; able to work outdoors (for some roles).

Post B – Masters of Ceremony

- (i) **Responsibilities:**
To be the MCs to facilitate smooth running of the camp.
- (ii) **Requirements:**
HKU current students with excellent command of spoken and written English and Chinese (Cantonese), confident, presentable, organised, detail-minded and have good communication skills; have MC experience in large-scale events are preferred.

Post C – Student Photographer

- (i) **Responsibilities:**
Capture the highlights of the camp and help edit the photos for publicity and promotion.
- (ii) **Requirements:**
HKU current students who are passionate in photography; have relevant photo editing skills (such as photoshop); able to work outdoors; possess photo-taking experience in large-scale events and have own video cameras for use are preferred (or provided by CEDARS).

Post D – Student Videographer

(iii) **Responsibilities:**

Capture the highlights of the camp and create a viral video for publicity.

(iv) **Requirements:**

HKU current students who are passionate in video shooting and production; have relevant video production and editing skills; able to work outdoors; possess video-taking experience in large-scale events and have own video cameras for use are preferred (or provided by CEDARS).
