Their parents do not have time to take care of them. As a result, they have relatively low self-esteem and possess grieved attitude towards life which seriously affect their performance in various aspects like academic, social life.

Migrant children are not inferior to any fellows. They have unique strengths and ability which worth confirmation and appreciation. In Feb-Dec 2014, 15 volunteers from the Migrant.Mission.Moved II Mentorship Program had established strong and warm mentorship and friendship with their respective mentees, who are migrant students in Kunming.
