- (ii) **Requirements:** HKU current students who are passionate in photography; have relevant photo editing skills (such as photoshop); able to work outdoors; possess photo-taking experience in large-scale events and have own video cameras for use are preferred (or provided by CEDARS).

Upon satisfactory performance and attendance, student photographer will be entitled to:
 - a. Honorarium of \$500 per one full day or \$250 per half day of duty;
 - b. Editing of photos for final output after the event: \$500; and

- (i) **Responsibilities:** Capture the highlights of the camp, conduct interviews with participants and create a viral video for publicity.
- (ii) **Requirements:** HKU current students who are passionate in video shooting and production; have relevant video production and editing skills; able to work outdoors; possess video-taking experience in large-scale events and have own video cameras for use are preferred (or provided by CEDARS).
- (iii) **Benefits and Rewards**
Upon satisfactory performance and attendance, student hosts will be entitled to:

- a. Honorarium of \$500 per one full day or \$250 per half day of duty;
- b. Production of video of the event: \$2,000; and
